Clifton Heritage Tour (3 hours) Cost: \$75.00 Children 12 & under with an adult \$60.00

Tour Guide arrives at Sheraton Hotel Pickup area: 9:15am
Tour departs from Sheraton Hotel Pickup area 9:30am

Pickup area is in front of Hotel and then on to outdoor exits. Tour guides will be holding B&W Business and Travel signage with escort to transportation.

Opening Tour (20 minutes)

Brief pass of Parliament House, the seat of Bahamian Legislative Government and then to Government House which is the official residence of the Governor General and Representative of the British Crown. Over to Arawak Cay, more commonly known as the Fish Fry with restaurants to satisfy late afternoon and evening palates and across the road is Fort Charlotte, which is the official ceremonial site for Government public outdoor functions and events. Bahamian businessman and developer Al Collie's La Luna, a newly developed entertainment complex. Down West Bay to the Christie and Demeritte residences, sites of known personages in present day politics of the Bahamas. Stop at Nettie Symonette's property, a longtime Bahamian hotelier, and then on to the former Castle home of retired Bahamian entertainer Peanuts Taylor and present owner, African-American entrepreneur Mike Roberts. Pass The Caves, then Bahamian roadside restaurant Travelers Rest and onto Gambier Village.

Gambier Village (15 minutes)

Gambier Village in the Bahamas is the first village settled by freed Africans rescued from ships engaged in illegal slave trading. See, hear and visit churches, village history, UNESCO site, elementary school and children, architecture and the private residence of the Governor General and his history.

Clifton Heritage National Park (70 minutes)
Visit the remnants of the Lucayan Indians and the Taino culture of South America Loyalists planters fleeing the newly formed United States of America and granted Crown Land from England and the African Slave arriving, seasoned and sold upon the entry into a portal resembling Africa remains intact at The Bahamas first national heritage park. Clifton Park, a preserved plantation tells the story of a confluence of three cultures of Africans,

Indians and Europeans evolved into the present day National Park. See Sacred Space (a tribute to African ancestors) and its connection to the present and past through the beauty of the sea and cliffs and as a memorial and statement of perseverance, preservation and transformation.
